## Agility and Steeplechase training in the ring show using food and toys!

This is a mini show where you can either run for clear rounds or use it as an opportunity to do some training in the ring. This show is different to our other shows as you can use TOYS and FOOD in the ring!!

Dig It DTC Just Eat shows are held in our indoor arena once a month which are fun and friendly! We want to encourage beginner handlers and dogs local to the Club to attend a small training show to gain experience and confidence in a show environment.

### Rules to using food.

- No crumbly or crunchy food.
- Toys with food in are allowed.
- Food must be large enough to be visually seen if dropped.
- Must be visible on orange sand if dropped.
- Must be delivered from the hand.

Limited to just 40 dogs – we hope to be finished by 5pm.

**CLASSES:** 3 runs per dog over an agility and steeplechase course. (2 x Agility runs and 1 x Steeplechase run) The handler can choose to include the seesaw and weaves. However please be aware as we cannot peg them in the Arena. Due to space and set up of the course there may be just one piece of contact equipment. (Aframe or dogwalk)

**ENTRIES:** £10.00 for 3 runs. Conformation of entries will be sent via email. BACS and Paypal Payments accepted. Paypal address [Lydia@digitdogs.co.uk](mailto:Lydia@digitdogs.co.uk)

**LEVELS:**

Only 1 level – Everyone runs the same course.

All heights available – Large, Standard, Medium, Small and Toy.

**ROSETTES:**

Clear round rosettes only and a bag of fish for dogs treats.

No places.

To be a clear round, the course must be completed within 60 seconds.

**HEIGHTS:**

A dog may only be entered in **one** height for the show.

	Height of dog	Height of jump
<b>Toy (Available for all levels)</b>	For dogs measuring 260mm or under at the withers.	Jump height 20cm
<b>Small</b>	For dogs measuring over 260mm, and measuring under 350mm at the withers	Jump height 30cm
<b>Medium</b>	dogs measuring over 350mm and measuring 17 inches 430mm or under at the withers	Jump height 40cm
<b>Standard</b>	For dogs measuring over 430mm and measuring 500mm or under at the withers	Jump height 50cm
<b>Large</b>	For dogs measuring over 500mm at the withers	Jump height 60cm

NB: Toy and standard heights are optional, the handler may choose to jump their normal KC height (small/large) if they prefer. We reserve the right to measure any entered dog. We accept KC record book or UKA measurements.

**COURSE TIME:** 60 seconds.

**SHOW INFO:**

A confirmation text or email will be sent to confirm receipt of your entries. Show information, running orders and ring plans will be available to download from our Website [www.digitdogs.co.uk](http://www.digitdogs.co.uk) and will be duplicated on our facebook page.

**RUNNING NFC:**

Most handlers use this opportunity and use food or toys in the ring. You get 60 seconds to do training in the ring and the scribe will shout ‘time’ when this time is up. You are then asked to make your way to the end and leave the arena.



## **SHOW RULES:**

1. Dogs under the age of 12 calendar months on the day of the show are not eligible to compete at the Just Eat/Speedy Steeplechase shows. Dogs have to run NFC and can choose their course or short sequence accordingly.
2. DIG IT DTC reserve the right to refuse entries.
3. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
4. Withdrawal of dogs from Competition - A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from an Agility Show if it is:
  - a. A bitch, which is in season.
  - b. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
  - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
  - d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
  - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
5. Dogs must be kept under control, and on lead, except when competing or within the exercise area. There is NO exercise area at this show.
6. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half slip collar or lead whilst competing. A flat close fitting leather or webbing collar is permitted. No tags please.
7. Competitors are required to report for allocated ring duties, to help with the smooth running of the show.
8. The judges decision is final.
9. Food rules.. see rule 17
10. All dogs and competitors enter at their own risk, and must agree to the declaration on the online entry form.
11. Entry fees will **not** be refunded after the closing date.
12. In the event that the show has to be cancelled, DIG IT DOGS reserve the right to deduct unrecoverable expenses incurred before returning entry fees.
13. Please park only where directed. Only use designated exercise areas. All other areas are out of bounds.
14. Judges may run their own dog for competition when not scheduled to judge.
15. Please respect our venue and pick up after your dogs and dispose of all rubbish responsibly. Anyone not doing so will be asked to leave the venue forfeiting any remaining entries and may be excluded from future DIG IT DTC shows.
16. Competitors are responsible for ensuring that they are available for their classes.
17. Rules to using food.
  - No crumbly or crunchy food.
  - Toys with food in are allowed.
  - Food must be large enough to be visually seen if dropped.
  - Must be visible on orange sand if dropped.
  - Must be delivered from the hand.

## **CATERING:**

There will be snacks for handlers – but not sandwiches. Hot drinks (50p) will be available and there will be an honesty box for payment.
